

# Latin Year 7 Assessment Tracker

Most students will start Year 7 with absolutely no previous experience with Latin language. All teaching and assessments are designed to help you start to learn this fascinating language. As we move through the year, the level of language and the tests will become more difficult. So if you achieve a “Secure” in your first assessment and a “Secure” in the last assessment, you will have made good progress.

If you manage to move from a “Secure” to a higher level such as “Extending”, then you are making excellent progress. If you go down a level, e.g. from “Secure” to “Developing” this doesn’t mean you’re getting worse. It just means that you haven’t mastered the more advanced vocabulary and grammar yet.

The minimum expectation for all students is to achieve a “Secure” at the end of each stage. You may be challenged with a higher minimum expectation if you show early promise in this subject.

Excelling	Consistent ability to accurately translate Latin into fluent English with excellent knowledge of vocabulary and grammar appropriate to the stage. Is able to offer a wide range of English derivatives and answer comprehension questions with precision.
Extending	Consistent ability to accurately translate Latin into English, although may not be entirely fluent. Excellent knowledge of vocabulary and grammar appropriate to the stage. Is able to offer a good range of English derivatives and answer comprehension questions.
Embedding	Ability to translate Latin into English with fair accuracy although some mistakes will have been made. Very good knowledge of vocabulary and a good grasp of Latin grammar appropriate to the stage. Is able to offer a good range of English derivatives and answer comprehension questions.
Secure	Ability to translate Latin into English so that the meaning remains largely unchanged, although some mistakes will have been made. Good knowledge of vocabulary and some grasp of Latin grammar appropriate to the stage. Is able to offer a range of English derivatives and answer comprehension questions with some accuracy.
Developing	Some ability to translate Latin into English, although several mistakes will have been made. A fair knowledge of vocabulary and limited grasp of Latin grammar appropriate to the stage. Is able to offer a range of English derivatives and answer comprehension questions with some accuracy.
Beginning	Limited ability to translate Latin into English and many mistakes will have been made. A basic knowledge of vocabulary and very limited grasp of Latin grammar appropriate to the stage. Is able to offer a basic range of English derivatives and answer some comprehension questions.
